Notice of Final Adoption of Water Quality Rules: Chapter 24

Please consider this memorandum as notice of final adoption of revised Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations. Chapter 24, Class VI Injection Wells and Facilities, Underground Injection Control Program, was modified to incorporate financial assurance requirements from W.S. § 35-11-313 and federal requirements found at 40 CFR 146.85; to incorporate liability insurance requirements from W.S. § 35-11-313; to incorporate conditions for conversion of other class wells to Class VI wells from W.S. § 35-11-313 and federal requirements found at 40 CFR 144.19; to incorporate federal conditions, found at 40 CFR 146.95, for a waiver of the requirement to inject below the lowermost underground source of drinking water (USDW); and to correct grammar and punctuation errors. A copy of Chapter 24 and a copy of the certification page are enclosed.

The Environmental Quality Council adopted the revised rules at a public hearing at Casper College, Strausner Hall, Room SH 217, 125 College Drive, Casper, Wyoming on June 15, 2016. The final rule was filed with the Wyoming Secretary of State on July 25, 2016.
