Dear Mr. Christiansen:

On June 10, 1991 I investigated a complaint that sewage was discharged onto the ground at the Crossed Arrows Park Subdivision. I four i and photographed sewage discharging from a pipe which appeared to be an inspection port for monitoring wastewater levels in the disposal field which is located along Saddle Hill Road. The sewage covered a large area and extended to a drainage east of the field. The disposal field is clearly failing.

W.S. 35-11-301(a)(i.) and Chapter II of the Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations provide that no person, except when authorized by a permit issued pursuant provisions of the act, shall cause, threaten or allow the discharge of any pollution or wastes. The owners of the Crossed Arrows Park Subdivision are in violation of W.S. 35-11-301(a)(i.) and Chapter II for discharging without a permit.

Any person who violates any provision of the Environmental Quality Act, or any rule, standard, permit, license or variance adopted thereunder, is liable to a penalty of ten thousand (\$10,000) for each day of violation. Penalties may be recovered in a civil action brought by the Attorney General in the name of the People of the State of Wyoming.

The Department of Environmental Quality, Water Quality Division (DEQ/WQD) would prefer to resolve this violation without resorting to legal action. Therefore, you need to take steps to stop the discharge and develop a permanent solution for your sewage disposal in accordance with all the applicable regulations.

Spoke to Steve Christiansen 2/18/92. He is responsible for subd. -Lee christiansen died in form, '92. Steve said leach field was repaired in Oct. '91 and it, only served one house.

Within 30 days of receipt of this letter, you must submit a schedule for compliance. Construction of a new disposal field or another type of treatment system must be completed in a timely manner. Please be aware that the DEQ/WQD must issue a permit to construct before construction begins and that an engineer licensed in Wyoming must sign the plans that are submitted.

Dear Mr. Christiansen:

On September 10, 1992 I stopped at Crossed Arrows Park to inspect the leach field area serving the subdivision. I stopped since in June of 1991 I found the leach field to be failing and requested that the system be repaired. In a March 2, 1992 letter you indicated that John Deromidi had fixed the problem. Yet in September I found indications that the leach field is still failing.

The leach field failure is a violation of the Department of Environmental Quality, Water Quality Division (DEQ/WQD) Rules and Regulations as well as a health hazard to the area residents. It appears that the leach field is not large enough to handle the wastewater flow and will need to be modified. A permit for modification is required before construction and must be obtained from either this office or Tim Morrison at the Park County Planning Office. I also suspect that the septic tanks in the subdivision need to be pumped. The pumping should be done immediately if they haven't been pumped in the last three years.

Please contact me as soon as possible so we can discuss this problem in greater detail.







#### **MEMORANDUM**

SUBJECT: Trip Report, Big Horn Basin: 15 May 1996

**DATE:** 16 May 1996

GOLDMARK ENGINEERING

The trip was in part at the request of Goldmark Engineering regarding the clean up of the pipeline break which occurred in January of this year.

The clean up is nearly finished. All of the free oil has been collected. Oil stained vegetation has been burned as has that crude oil which could not be collected. Oil saturated soil has been collected and stored in a pipe yard. Total volume of this soil is less that 100 cubic yards.

The areas that were inaccessible to machinery were cleaned with hand labor.

I inspected several long reaches of the drainage area and found the area to be satisfactorily cleaned of any crude oil stain. Those areas in which there was some evidence of staining have been hand raked so as to expose the oil to the air.

The siphon structures are still in place on dikes two and three and will remain until all evidence of the spilled oil is gone.

I recommend that we inspect this area in July or August for a final clean up assessment.

#### CROSSED ARROWS SUBDIVISION

Photographs were taken of the leach field area on May 15, 1996. The leach field is again failing. As the photographs show, effluent water is freely flowing from the leach field riser. This water is flowing over the property line to the north and is saturating the area adjacent to a high pressure natural gas line. This moisture adjacent to this high pressure line could help to create an accelerated corrosion environment. The line belongs to Cody Gas Company and they have been notified of the situation.

### JIM ENIS FAILED LEACH FIELD

The residence of Jim Enis is located at 1123 Missouri Flat Road approximately 13 miles northwest of Thermopolis. Phone 864-2338 ask for Julie Enis if a call is necessary.

The leach field has failed. The effluent appears to go into an earthen pit at the end of the leachfield. It appears that the soil in the vicinity of the house is a very tight bentonitic clay. A backhoe pit could verify if a conventional leachfield, infiltrators or other structure could suffice of if a constructed wetland would be more appropriate. Photographs of the failed leach field were taken.

RE: Septic tank leach field discharge onto transmission line ROW

Mr. Good:

Pursuant to our phone conversation this morning this letter is to advise you of a potential corrosion situation you may be experiencing on your transmission line.

The Crossed Arrows mobile home subdivision, a short distance north of Meeteetse, is served by individual septic tanks all tied into a community leach field near the entrance road into the subdivision.

This leach field is failing, i.e., waste water is surfacing near the east end of the field and is draining off the area and onto your gas transmission line ROW. This situation has been occurring for at least a month. The waste water nearly always contains anaerobic bacteria, some of which are iron reducing. There is usually hydrogen sulfide in this waste water. This wet area along your line in an otherwise dry environment has a tendency to promote a corrosion hot spot due to the ease with which ions and currents can travel. The waste water is a continual source of deleterious ions and bacteria.

I request that you investigate this situation as a matter of public safety.






# Crossed Arrows Subdivision Leach Field Failure


