10	PETITIONS FOR AWARD OF COSTS AND EXPENSES UNDER W.S. 35-11-437(f)

12	Section 1. Petition and Answer.
13	
14	(a) As described in W.S. 35-11-437(f), any person may file a petition for
15	award of costs and expenses <u>must be filed with the Council</u> within forty-five (45) days of
16	receipt of a final order from the Council, in accordance with Chapter 2, Section 5 of these
17	rules. Any person served with a copy of the petition shall have thirty (30) days from
18	service within which to file an answer to the petition. Failure to make a timely filing of
19	the petition may constitute a waiver of the right to such an award.
20	
21	(b) The petition shall contain the petitioner's name and a detailed accounting,
22	including receipts, of all costs and expenses authorized under W.S. 35-11-437(f). Where
23	attorneys' fees are claimed, the petition shall include evidence concerning the hours
24	expended on the case, the customary commercial rate of payment for such services in the
25	area, and the experience, reputation and ability of the individual(s) performing the
26	services.

28	(c) Any proceeding to award costs under W.S. 35-11-437(f) shall follow the
29	contested case procedures outlined in Chapter 2 of these rules.

31	Section 2. Who May Receive an Award.
