The Solid and Hazardous Waste Division of the Department of Environmental Quality is proposing to adopt EPA mandatory revisions to the Hazardous Waste Rules and Regulations Chapter 1 and is requesting the Environmental Quality Council review the proposal and consider adoption of these rules at your February 19, 2019 hearing.

The revisions were presented to the Wyoming Water and Waste Advisory Board (WWAB) at the June 21, 2018 meeting. The WWAB recommended approval of the Chapter 1 of the Wyoming HWRR, which are an Incorporation by Reference (IBR) of the Federal Title 40 Code of Federal Regulations. The revised rules represent an update of the rules from the last revision in 2015. The Governor's Office approved proceeding with the proposed rule on October 4, 2018.
