Mr. Smith was the permit coordinator for the Wilson Brothers mine permit application TFN 5 6/125. Mr. Smith will testify about his education, training and experience, his duties as a Natural Resource Program Principal and permit coordinator for the Department, and his work on the Wilson Brothers bentonite mine permit application, TFN 5 6/125. He will testify generally about the procedures the Department employs when reviewing and approving applications for

mining permits. He will testify about the scope of the Land Quality Division's jurisdiction, its lack of authority over the use of roads outside the permit boundary, and its lack of authority to issue permits regulating emissions. He will testify about his knowledge, observations, and opinions regarding the Wilson Brothers permit application, the Department's review and processing of that application, the mine and reclamation plan submitted by Wilson Brothers, and the objections raised against the application. In particular, he will testify based upon his education, training, and experience and his review of the Wilson Brothers mine permit application, that the application is complete and technically sufficient, that the application was properly processed by the Department, and that the application complies with the Environmental Quality Act and all applicable federal and state laws. In addition, he will testify to the Department's conclusion that the proposed mine will not constitute a public nuisance and will not endanger the public health and safety. He may also rebut any opinions or evidence offered by any other party.

The Department reserves the right to call any of the witnesses identified by any other party, or any additional witnesses necessary for foundation, impeachment, or rebuttal.
