It should also be noted that between baseline collection for this amendment and submittal, American Colloid Company constructed a road through this amendment area, therefore the baseline collection does not reflect that disturbance area.

**BPM 99** 

The proposed disturbance associated with this amendment is expected to begin in 2020 and is bonded by Self Bond SBNC132. The proposed disturbance for the WY S04 amendment will be accounted for in the corresponding Annual Report and bond calculation for the year disturbance commences.

Two areas within the amendment area are currently under review for Jurisdictional Determination with the Army Corps of Engineers. Initial correspondence with USACE has indicated that the results will likely be in the mine's favor, however once the determination has been completed that information will be added to the wetlands section of the application. In addition BPM understands approval of these areas by USACE will be received before permit approval of this disturbance occurs.
