- 1. The Environmental Quality Council, pursuant to the authority vested in it by the Wyoming Statutes 35-11-112 (a)(i), has revised, removed, or added the following chapters and sections to the Wyoming Air Quality Standards and Regulations: Chapter 5, National Emission Standards, Section 3, National emission standards for hazardous air pollutants.
- 2. Section 35-11-202 (a) of the Environmental Quality Act states that the Administrator, after consultation with the Advisory Board, shall recommend to the Director such ambient air standards and regulations that may be necessary to prevent, abate, or control pollution.

Section 35-11-202 (b) of the Act states that in recommending such standards the Administrator shall consider all facts and circumstances bearing upon the reasonableness of the emissions involved including:

- (A) The character and degree of injury to, or interference with the health and physical well being of the people, animals, wildlife and plant life;
- (B) The social and economic value of the source of pollution;
- (C) The priority of location in the area involved;
- (D) The technical practicability and economic reasonableness of reducing or eliminating the pollution; and
- (E) The social welfare and aesthetic value.
- 3. Chapter 5, National Emission Standards, Section 3, National emission standards for hazardous air pollutants, has been updated to include 40 CFR Subpart 63 XXXXXX National Emission Standards for Hazardous Air Pollutants Area Standards for Nine Metal Fabrication and Finishing Source Categories,

and purpose of the Act, as stated in W.S. 35-11-102, and that they have been promulgated in accordance with rulemaking provisions of the Wyoming Administrative Procedures Act.
