Chapter 1, General Provisions, IBR Update 2

The Department of Environmental Quality, Solid and Hazardous Waste Division (SHWD) is proposing revisions to the Hazardous Waste Rules and Regulations Chapter 1, General Provisions, which are updates to EPA regulations being incorporated by reference (IBR). SHWD is requesting the Environmental Quality Council review the proposal and consider adoption of these rules at your November 16, 2021 hearing.

The proposed revisions were presented to the Water and Waste Advisory Board (WWAB) on June 29, 2021, at which the WWAB recommended approval. The Governor's Office has approved proceeding with the proposed rules.
