SUBJECT: Request for Review of Proposed Rules for Statutory Authority (R-34)

The Department of Environmental Quality, Air Quality Division (Division) is proposing to revise Chapter 6, Permitting Requirements, of the Wyoming Air Quality Standards and Regulations (WAQSR). Chapter 6, Section 2(o)(iii), Permit requirements for construction, modification, and operation, is being updated to include revisions to portable relocate fee assessments that were established under Wyo. Stat. § 35-11-211(j) after the passage of HB0049 during the 2021 legislative session.

This rulemaking was reviewed by the Air Quality Advisory Board (AQAB) on September 29, 2021, and the Board recommended that the rules proceed to formal rulemaking before the Environmental Quality Council (EQC).

The Division did not receive written comments during the public process.

The Division has reviewed the requirements of section 35-11-202(a) and (b) of the Wyoming Environmental Quality Act and determined this rulemaking to be in procedural compliance with the statute. Finally, the Division has reviewed and responded to the Takings Guidelines and Checklist provided by the Attorney General's Office. The Division is now seeking a review of the proposed rules for statutory authority prior to submitting the rules to the Governor's Office for permission to proceed to formal rulemaking.
