Authorization to Discharge Storm Water Associated Mineral Mining Activities (except fuels) Under the Wyoming Pollutant Discharge Elimination System

In compliance with the provisions of Chapter 2 of the Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations, the Wyoming Environmental Quality Act, and the federal Water Pollution Control Act,

Asphalt Specialties, Co., Inc.

Lone Tree Creek Quarry

NE/4 & SESE Section 23 and NWSW Section 24, Township 13 North, Range 70 West, Laramie County

and located within the State of Wyoming which has or may discharge storm water associated with industrial activities, is hereby authorized to discharge to the surface waters of the State of Wyoming in accordance with the requirements of this permit which was issued April 1, 2018.

Coverage under the general permit expires 3/31/2023.

This facility has been assigned permit authorization number WYR320848

Authorization under this general permit is effective beginning 7/20/2018.

If a copy of the general permit was requested, it is attached. Facilities required to sample storm water runoff will also receive appropriate reporting forms.
