Dear Ms. Bush:

We can allow you to phone in to the hearing to participate. However, your witnesses must be present at the hearing room. They cannot participate by phone.

I do not know how you will get your exhibits to the parties before the hearing at 1:00 on Monday. You will need to have your exhibits at the hearing in Gillette so that they can be marked and entered into the record. You cannot offer them from Canada and then send them in. The parties and the Council will need hard copies of each exhibit at the time of the hearing so that when you wish to offer them, the parties will be able to review them and object if they wish. The Council will need to have the hard copies so that they can rule on any objections and the Court reporter will need hard copies so that they can be placed in the record. Based upon my review of your recent and past filings, I am not sure you can adequately explain which document you wish to offer at any given point because of the number of documents you are anticipating you will offer. However, that is a logistical problem that you will need to overcome in whatever way you feel will give you the best chance of getting the document into the record over any objections raised by the parties.

We may be able to call you to give you the number but I cannot even guarantee that. So, email is the sure way to insure we can get you the phone number.
