REQUEST FOR POSTPONEMENT OF APPEAL AND REQUEST FOR HEARING

- 1. Mountain Cement Company believes there are actions it can take to cause its facility to comply with all opacity requirements of State law.

- 5. Mountain Cement Company intends to fully cooperate with the Department of Environmental Quality, Air Quality Division in order to resolve all concerns of the Division.

6. Upon completion of all work directed to be performed by outside consultants on the electrostatic precipitator, Mountain Cement Company believes the Order will have been complied with and this Appeal will become moot.
