## NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT:

- Facility number 0-001616 is located at 110 West Seventh, Lusk, Wyoming. There are two temporarily out of use underground storage tanks on this facility. On May 11, 2005, Brad H. Hall was invoiced for underground storage tank fees and provided with an annual registration form filled out for the facility. On August 24, 2005 and September 27, 2005, Brad H. Hall was again invoiced for underground storage tank fees. The responsibility for underground storage tank fees rests with either the owner or the operator, and Brad H. Hall is registered as both the owner and the operator. Underground storage tank fees have not been paid for fiscal year 2006. Presently Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) remains unpaid, and the fiscal year 2006 registration has not been submitted;
- 2. Brad H. Hall has failed to pay underground storage tank fees which are mandatory under W.S. 35-11-1425, and has failed to register the tanks as required by W.S. 35-11-1419 and Chapter 17, Section 7(b), Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations;
- 3. Since the underground storage tank fees have not been paid for fiscal year 2006 and those fees were due July 1, 2005, Brad H. Hall is required to provide financial responsibility under Chapter 19, Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations;
- 4. W.S. 35-11-1419 states: "On or before July 1 of each year the owner or operator of a tank shall register the tank with the department on forms developed and furnished by the department."
- W.S. 35-11-1425 states: "On or before July 1 of each year either the owner or operator of a tank shall pay a fee to the department of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) per tank owned or operated, except that the owner or operator of an aboveground storage tank subject to this section that holds five thousand (5,000) gallons or less shall pay a fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00) per tank owned or operated. This fee shall be deposited in the corrective action account."
- Chapter 17, Section 7(b), states: "On or before July 1 of each year either the owner and/or operator of an underground storage tank system shall register the system with the department on forms developed and furnished by the department. The registration form shall be submitted under oath or affirmation."
- Chapter 17, Section 7(e)(iii), states: "(e) All owners and/or operators of new underground storage tank systems must certify on the notification or certification of compliance form conformance with the following requirements: (iii) Financial responsibility under Chapter 19, Water Quality Rules and Regulations, Underground Storage Tank Program Financial Responsibility."
- By failing to pay underground storage tank fees for facility 0-001616, Brad H. Hall, has violated W.S. 35-11-1425. By failing to register the tanks on facility 0-001616, Brad H. Hall has violated W.S. 35-11-1419 and Chapter 17, Section 7(b), Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations. By failing to provide financial responsibility for facility 0-001616, Brad H. Hall has violated Chapter 17, Section 7(e)(iii), and Chapter 19, Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations;
- the failure to correct or remedy an alleged violation, the director of the Department of Environmental Quality shall cause a written notice to be issued and served upon the person alleged to be responsible.

#### **ORDER**

# BEFORE THE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY COUNCIL-STATE OF WYOMING

# WHEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT BRAD H. HALL SHALL:

- 1. Within thirty (30) days of the receipt of this notice, pay all underground storage tank fees for facility 0-001616. The underground storage tank fees for this site total Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00);
- 2. Within thirty (30) days of the receipt of this notice, file the registration form for the underground storage tanks at facility 0-001616, as required by W.S. 35-11-1419;
- 3. If items 1 and 2 are complied with, this will constitute full compliance with this Administrative Order. The remaining items on this Order shall be complied with if items 1, 2 and 3 are not complied with within thirty (30) days:

## OR

- 4. Within thirty (30) days of the receipt of this notice empty both tanks within one inch of the bottom. These tanks are presently registered with the department as "temporarily out of service" tanks. Disconnect all underground piping from the tank until such time as it can be placed back in service;
- 5. Enter into a written agreement with the department as to when the underground storage tank fees will be paid;
- 6. If these tanks have not been placed back in service within one (1) year of the date of this Administrative Order, Brad H. Hall shall, at its own expense remove the tanks, decommission them at a licensed facility, and notify the department thirty (30) days in advance so that a department inspector can witness the removals.

THIS ORDER is final unless, not later than ten (10) days after the date this notice is received, it is appealed by filing two written petitions for a hearing before the Environmental Quality Council. If a hearing is requested, the first petition shall be mailed to the Chairman, Wyoming Environmental Quality Council, Room 1714 Herschler Building, 1st Floor West, 122 West 25th Street, Cheyenne, Wyoming 82002. The second petition shall be mailed to the Director, Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality, Herschler Building, 4th Floor West, 122 West 25th Street, Cheyenne, Wyoming 82002. Both petitions must be sent by certified mail, return receipt requested.

NOTHING IN THIS ORDER shall be interpreted to in any way limit or contravene any other remedy available under the Environmental Quality Act, nor shall this Order be interpreted as being a condition precedent to any other enforcement action.
