Chapter 6, Permitting Requirements, Section 13, Nonattainment new source review permit requirements, is amended, in part, to comply with portions of 40 CFR 51.165 and its appendices, July 1, 2014.

Chapter 6, Permitting Requirements, Section 14, Incorporation by reference, adopts by reference portions of 40 CFR parts 51, 52, 60, 61, 63, 70, 75 and 98, and appendices to parts 51, 58 and 60, July 1, 2014.
