The Environmental Quality Council (EQC) will consider proposed changes to the Wyoming Air Quality Standards and Regulations (WAQSR) brought forth by the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality (WDEQ) Air Quality Division (AQD) at a public hearing to be held at 9:00 a.m. on September 9, 2015, at the Community Building, 18 Fairgrounds Road, Buffalo, Wyoming.

The AQD will present the proposed rulemaking to the EQC. The proposed rulemaking will involve revising WAQSR Chapter 2, Sections 2 and 12, along with Chapter 6, Sections 13 and 14. Chapter 2, Ambient Standards, Section 2, Ambient standards for particulate matter, will be updated to include the latest PM_{2.5} National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS). Section 12, Incorporation by reference, is being updated to adopt by reference from the Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) for July 1, 2014. Chapter 6, Permitting Requirements, Section 13, Nonattainment new source eview permit requirements, will be updated to include specific nonattainment new source review permit requirements. Section 14, Incorporation by reference, is being updated to adopt by reference from the CFR for July 1, 2014. Chapter 2, Section 2, and Chapter 6, Section 13, involve changes to the State Implementation Plan (SIP). The AQD will submit hese SIP changes to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).
