NOTICE OF SATISFACTION OF ORDER NO. 2336-91

The Department of Environmental Quality ("DEQ"), Solid & Hazardous Waste Division issued Notice of Violation & Order No. 2336-91 to Mr. James Cook on December 2, 1991. The Notice described certain activities and conditions at the Jim's Towing Service site located at 1443 U.S. Highway 30 East, Eagle Industrial Park, Lot 4, Evanston, Wyoming, alleged to be in violation of specified state standards, and the Order prescribed corrective actions to be taken. Mr. Cook filed a petition for review before the Wyoming Environmental Quality Council under W.S. 35-11-701 and a hearing was held in Rock Springs on October 20, 1992. Following the hearing, the Council entered Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order dated February 10, 1993; which affirmed the original DEQ Order, but extended the time for compliance. The DEQ Solid & Hazardous Waste Division has monitored compliance with the terms of Order No. 2336-91 and hereby notifies the Council that all terms of that Order have now been satisfied.
