#### NOTICE OF VIOLATION AND ORDER

#### NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT:

- Coronado Oil Company (Coronado) is the owner of oil and gas production facilities in Wyoming which are permitted to discharge through the Wyoming Pollution Discharge Elimination System permits WY0025127, WY0039390 and WY0041891.
- 2. Part I of the above referenced permits, under the Monitoring and Reporting section, requires effluent monitoring results to be summarized and reported on a Discharge Monitoring Report (DMR) form. The WQD sent a Letter of Violation (LOV) to Coronado on December 8<sup>th</sup>, 2007 instructing them to send in all delinquent DMRs to the WQD. The WQD did not receive a response to the LOV and did not receive any delinquent DMRs.
- 3. This Notice is being sent to you pursuant to W.S. 35-11-701(c)(i), which requires that in any case of the failure to correct or remedy an alleged violation, the director of the Department of Environmental Quality shall cause a written notice to be issued and served upon the person alleged to be responsible;

# WHEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

- Coronado shall immediately submit complete and accurate delinquent DMRs to the WQD. This
  information shall be received by the WQD no later than 60 days after the receipt of the NOV by
  Coronado.
- Coronado shall submit to the WQD a plan of action to ensure all DMRs are filled out correctly and submitted in at timely manner in the future.

This ORDER is final unless, no later than ten (10) days after the date this notice is received; it is appealed by filing two written requests for a hearing before the Environmental Quality Council. If a hearing is requested, the first hearing petition shall be mailed to the Chairman, Wyoming Environmental Quality Council, Room 1714 Herschler Building, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor West, 122 West 25<sup>th</sup> St., Cheyenne, Wyoming 82002. The second petition shall be mailed to the Director, Wyoming Department of the Environmental Quality, Herschler Building, 4<sup>th</sup> Floor West, 122 West 25<sup>th</sup> St., Cheyenne, Wyoming 82002. Both petitions must be sent by certified mail, return receipt requested.

NOTHING IN THIS NOTICE OF VIOLATION (NOV) AND ORDER shall be interpreted to in any way limit or contravene any other remedy available under the Environmental Quality Act, nor shall this NOV AND ORDER be interpreted as being a condition precedent to any other enforcement action.
