Dear Mr. Hacker:

On March 13, 2015, NOV Docket Number 5535-15 was issued to Hacker Oil, Inc. The NOV included an Order that required Hacker Oil, Inc., to properly place the underground storage tanks (USTs) located at the South Main Sinclair in temporarily out of use status and to obtain a Class A and B Storage Tank Operator for the facility. The NOV was affirmed by the Environmental Quality Council on May 19, 2015.

On November 17, 2015, Hacker Oil, Inc., removed the tanks at the South Main Sinclair. For this reason, the DEO Storage Tank Program now considers this NOV resolved and the Fuel Delivery Prohibition (Red Tag) Order has now bene lifted.
