Thank you for talking with the Teton County Commissioners May 11, 2016. I was in attendance and heard the conference call.

My property is adjacent to the Rodger Sherr-Toss property. We are concerned with the air quality this operation will cause. Our daughter has ARDS (acute respiratory distress syndrome) so we are mindful of dust and pollutants.

This operation will have an adverse impact on all surrounding neighborhoods.

Big Trails subdivision is horse properties. Because West Nile disease is a threat, I ask that any standing ponds be monitored and treated by the county weed and pest.

This mining operation is surrounded by residential properties. It is also in the Teton County scenic overlay so enlarging this operation will affect both neighborhoods and visitors alike.

I do not understand the use of the amenity ponds. Many of us have ponds but we have to go through the county permitting process. What is the difference between an amenity pond and a stock pond?
