I am writing in response to your letter received in on the 21st of September, 2011. As you may be aware, on November 14, 2011, Ambre Energy North America, Inc., through its wholly-owned subsidiary KCP, Inc., purchased a 100% interest in the Big Horn Mine. This mine was purchased from Level 3 Communications, Inc., and now the mine is being managed by AECOal.

At this time, AECOal is evaluating the potential for future resource extraction at or around the Big Horn Mine. Within the next two years, we will conduct prospecting activities within the area of the mine site to further evaluate the potential for future development and to determine the value of the remaining asset. The need for the shop/ facilities area is essential for our plan of development and will be used as a storage facility for both agricultural and industrial purposes.

AECOal is in concurrence with your statement in which some lands are now ready for final bond release. We have every intention on working with your staff at the District III office to achieve final bond release on those remaining lands.
