

CHAPTER 9

SUSPENSION OF PERMITS FOR NEW COMMERCIAL
SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT FACILITIES

REPEALED

~~Section 1. Authority. The authority for this regulation is the Wyoming Environmental Quality Act, W.S. 35-11-101 through 1304. Specific sections of the Act that provide authority for this regulation include W.S. 35-11-102, 35-11-109, 35-11-502, and 35-11-503.~~

~~Section 2. Definitions. For the purpose of this chapter, unless the context otherwise requires:~~

~~(a) "Commercial solid waste management facility" means any facility receiving a monthly average greater than five hundred (500) short tons per day of unprocessed household refuse or mixed household and industrial refuse for management or disposal.~~

~~Section 3. Temporary Suspension - New Permits For Commercial Facilities. On and after the effective date of this rule, the director shall not issue permits for commercial solid waste management facilities. This permit suspension shall continue until the Environmental Quality Council promulgates rules and regulations providing for resumption of permitting by the director.~~

~~Section 4. Permit systems. Solid waste management facilities may not be constructed or operated without a permit which demonstrates compliance with the technical standards and procedural requirements of the Wyoming Solid Waste Management Rules and Regulations. Any permitted facility shall operate in compliance with current or amended technical and procedural solid waste management rules and regulations.~~

~~Section 5. Effective date. This rule is effective upon filing with the Secretary of State in accord with W.S. 16-3-103(b).~~
