NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ), Water Quality Division (WQD) issued Notice of Violation and Order Docket Number **5529-15** on June 23, 2016 to Dave's Asphalt Company (DAC) for operating without a Wyoming Pollution Discharge Elimination System (WYPDES), Industrial Storm Water permit, as required under Wyoming Water Quality Rules and Regulations (WQRR).

The Notice of Violation and Order **#5529-15** required DAC to obtain authorization to operate under an Industrial storm water permit. Based on reviewed information submitted by the Wyoming Attorney General's office DAC has complied with the conditions of the Order for Docket Number **5529-15** and the DEQ finds that all terms have been satisfied.

The DEQ looks forward to working with DAC in a proactive manner and is available for future meetings to discuss compliance issues or concerns regarding WYPDES permit requirements.
