- 2. All Discovery including but not limited to written interrogatories, requests for production of documents etc in this case shall be served on or before November 13, 2017. Responses to discovery shall be served on or before December 18, 2017. These deadlines do not apply to the taking of depositions. Depositions can be taken up and until February 9, 2018.
- 3. The parties shall exchange a list of witnesses no later than January 5, 2018.
- 4. Should the parties agree that the final hearing will last less than 2 days they shall inform the Council as soon as possible.
- 5. All dispositive motions shall be filed by January 4, 2018 and responses to the motion(s) shall be filed by January 29, 2018..
- 6. Exhibits for the final hearing will be served on each party and filed electronically with the EQC on or before 12:00 noon on February 14, 2018. The parties shall have one hard copy available for the Counsel on the day of the final hearing for inclusion in the record.
