1. *Does the action affect private property?* No. The proposed revisions to Chapter 27 affect the financial assurance for Class I hazardous waste and non-hazardous waste underground injection facilities and Class V coalbed methane produced water underground injection facilities that are required to demonstrate financial assurance under W.S. 35-11-302(a)(viii). The proposed revisions do not affect economic use or value of the regulated facilities.
