Summary: The Department is proposing to amend Solid Waste Rules and Regulations Chapter 4 and Chapter 6. The proposed revisions consolidate and streamline permitting for construction/demolition waste landfills and solid waste transfer, treatment and storage facilities. Additionally, the revisions update the rules to be consistent with previously revised chapters of the Solid Waste Rules and Regulations. These proposed revisions were approved by the Water and Waste Advisory Board on October 18, 2018. Specific information on the changes can be found in the Statement of Principal Reasons.
