The Solid and Hazardous Waste Division (SHWD) of the Department of Environmental Quality is proposing revisions to the Solid Waste Rules and Regulations Chapter 4 and Chapter 6 and is requesting the Environmental Quality Council review the proposal and consider adoption of these rules at your February 19, 2019 hearing.
