ROCKY MOUNTAIN POWER PUBLIC NOTICE

Notice is given that the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act and the Public Service Commission's (Commission) Rules, regarding the Application of Rocky Mountain Power (Company) for authority to revise Rule 12, as more fully set forth in the attached public utility as defined in Wyo. Stat. § 37-1-101, are subject to the Commission's jurisdiction pursuant to W.S. § 37-2-112.

Application on September 21, 2018, requesting authority to revise Rule 12 - Line Extension policy. RMP states when Rule 12 was developed, there were concerns about line extension allowances for large loads that could be transient in nature, which could harm other customers if the proposed load did not materialize or if the customer went bankrupt. RMP would like to revise Section III to read "Application of a speculative nature or of questionable permanent duration or size of load that exceed the Company's guideline loading limits for one circuit at the local distribution level shall take delivery at the locally available transmission voltage (46,000 volts or above)." RMP is requesting to revise Section III of Rule 12 due to an existing customer that is currently being provided electric service from a V distribution system. The customer is undergoing an expansion that will increase its demand from 8 megawatts to approximately 11 megawatts. Under the existing Section III, the customer is required to take delivery at the Company's transmission voltage (6 kV or above). The revision would allow RMP to evaluate any future or existing customer's production and provide a line extension allowance and distribution level if the proposed load expansion is to be a stable and long-term load addition to ensure

Wilson Brothers Construction, Inc. Regular Mining Permit Application

Wilson Brothers Construction Inc. of Cowley, WY has applied for a regular mining permit from the Land Quality Division of the Department of Environmental Quality for the State of Wyoming. The mining permit area for the mining of bentonite will be located in: Section 28, Township 52 North, Range 102 West, Park County, Wyoming. The area is approximately 5 miles southwest of Cody, WY near Park County road 6UU. The proposed operation is scheduled to begin December, 2018 and is estimated to continue until 2024.

Information regarding this application may be reviewed in the Office of the Land Quality Division of the Department of Environmental Quality in Cheyenne and Lander or the Park County Clerk's Office, Cody, Wyoming. Written objections to the proposed mining operation must be received by the Administrator of the Land Quality Division of the Department of Environmental Quality, 200 W. 17th Street, Suite 10, Cheyenne, WY 82002, before the close of business November 22, 2018. If an objection specifically requests a public hearing before the Environmental Quality Council, a public hearing shall be held within twenty (20) days after the final date for filing objections unless a different period is stipulated to by the parties. The Environmental Quality Council or Director shall publish notice of the time, date and location of the hearing or conference in a newspaper of general circulation in the locality of the proposed operation once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks immediately prior to the hearing or conference. The hearing shall be conducted as a contested case in accordance with the Wyoming Administrative Procedure Act (W.S. §16-3-101 through §16-3-115), and the right of judicial review shall be afforded as provided in that Act. All parties as given in W.S. §35-11-406(j) will be mailed a copy of this notice. The Wyoming Oil and Gas Conservation Commission will be mailed a copy of the application mine plan map as required in W.S. §35-11-406(j).
