2U Ranch LLC hereby moves the hearing officer of the Environmental Quality Council to compel Bentonite Performance Minerals, LLC (BPM) to Answer the Interrogatories and respond to the Request for Production of Documents which previously (6 November 2018) were submitted to BPM in good faith.

BPM did respond to the Interrogatories and Request for Production. However, it clearly appears that BPM did not comply with this discovery in good faith.

The Members of the Council at a hearing on 16 January 2019 stated the standards which the Council expected in proceedings before this administrative body. These standards are that all information should be freely forthcoming and gamesmanship is not looked upon in favor. The council further stated that gamesmanship should better be used in legal proceedings in district court and not before this administrative body.
