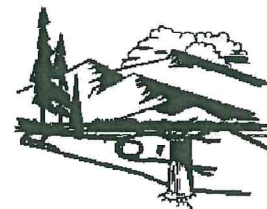

SUBJECT: Hearing Request for Water Quality Rules and Regulations Chapter 24

The Department of Environmental Quality, Water Quality Division is proposing revisions to Water Quality Rules and Regulations Chapter 24 and is requesting the Environmental Quality Council review the proposal and consider adoption of these rules at your November 19, 2019 hearing.

The proposed revisions to Chapter 24 were presented to the Water and Waste Advisory Board (WWAB) at the June 25, 2019 meeting, at which the WWAB recommended approval of the proposed rule. The Governor's Office has approved proceeding with the proposed rule.
