SCHEDULING ORDER

This matter came before this hearing officer in this matter on Thursday, August 13, 2020 at 10:30 a.m. for a status conference. Counsel for all parties were present. As a result of the status conference, the following schedule will apply to this matter:

- 1. August 31, 2020 the parties shall exchange a preliminary witness list and list of documents that each party may use at the contested case hearing to support their claims and/or defenses.
- 2. September 30, 2020 Powder River Basin Resource Council shall serve upon the other parties its expert witness designation.
- 3. October 21, 2020 DEQ and Brook Mine shall serve upon the other parties their expert witness designations.
- 4. October 30, 2020 Discovery cutoff with the exception of expert witness depositions.
- 5. October 30, 2020 Last day to file all prehearing and dispositive motions. The timelines to file responses and replies to any motion shall be governed by Chapter 2, Section 11 of DEQ's Contested Case Hearing rules. Oral argument on motions will be scheduled at a later date, if necessary.

- 7. January 8, 2021 Prehearing disclosure statements and a complete set of all exhibits each party may introduce into evidence at the contested case hearing shall be served upon the parties and filed with the Council. Prehearing disclosure statements shall comply with the requirements outlined in Chapter 2, Section 18 of DEQ's Contested Case Hearing rules. Each party's exhibits shall be bound in a spiral or ring binder and all exhibits shall be tabbed and every page numbered so that every page presented to the Council can be specifically identified. The parties shall also include a separate index list of all exhibits, which identifies each exhibit and corresponding page number. In order for each Council member to have a copy of the exhibits, each party shall provide an original and seven copies of its exhibits to the Council.
- 8. **January 13, 2021 at 10:00 a.m.** Prehearing conference to be held in Cheyenne at a location to be announced.
- 9. **January 19 through January 22, 2021** Contested case to be held in Cheyenne at a location to be announced. The parties have agreed to waive the thirty day deadline in which to hold the contested case hearing.
- 10. The burden of proof in this matter is on the objector, Power River Basin Resource Council.
- 11. The filing of documents and exhibits with the Council shall be filed via the e-file docket site. The e-file docket site will automatically name and number the exhibits so please do not name and number the originals until after they have been filed. When filing exhibits, identify

- 12. All parties should continue to make reasonable efforts towards achieving settlement of this matter.
