Subject: Hearing Request for Wyoming Solid Waste Rules and Regulations Chapter 1 and Chapter 7

The Department of Environmental Quality, Solid and Hazardous Waste Division (SHWD) is proposing revisions to the Solid Waste Rules and Regulations Chapter 1 and Chapter 7 and is requesting the Environmental Quality Council review the proposal and consider adoption of these rules at your August 17, 2021 hearing.

The proposed revisions were presented to the Water and Waste Advisory Board (WWAB) on March 23, 2021, at which the WWAB recommended approval of the proposed rules. The Governor's Office has approved proceeding with the proposed rules.
