

Proposed Rulemaking Package (R-34)

The Air Quality Division (Division) of the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality is proposing revisions Chapter 6, Permitting Requirements, of the Wyoming Air Quality Standard and Regulations (WAQSR). The Division is requesting the Environmental Quality Council to review the proposal and to consider the adoption of these rules when you meet in Gillette, Wyoming on February 15, 2022.

In this proposed rulemaking, WAQSR Chapter 6, Permitting Requirements, Section 2(o)(iii), Permit requirements for construction, modification, and operation, will be updated to include revisions to portable relocate fee assessments that were established under Wyo. Stat. § 35-11-211(j) after the passage of HB0049 during the 2021 legislative session.

The Division issued a notice for public comment on this set of revisions prior to the September 29, 2021 Air Quality Advisory Board (AQAB) meeting, with the public comment period running from August 29, 2021 to September 29, 2021. There were no comments received on the proposed rules. At the September 29, 2021 meeting, the AQAB recommended that the rules proceed to a formal rulemaking before the Environmental Quality Council.
