Public Notice Period

Response to NO Public Comments

The Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality – Air Quality Division (WDEQ AQD) initiated a public notice period related to proposed changes to Wyoming Air Quality Standards and Regulations (WAQSR) Chapter 6, Permitting Requirements, Section 2, Permit requirements for construction, modification, and operation. WDEQ-AQD published a public notice stating the intent to propose rule changes in the Casper Star-Tribune on December 15, 2021, which ended on January 28, 2022, prior to the February 15, 2022 Environmental Quality Council (EQC) hearing. Notice was also provided to interested parties that are subscribed to the WDEQ-AQD GovDelivery electronic listserv.

Chapter 6, Section 2(o)(iii), Portable Relocate Fees, is being updated to include revisions to portable relocate fee assessments as required by Wyo. Stat. § 35-11-211(j) after the passage of HB0049 during the 2021 legislative session.

No written comments were received during the 45-day public comment period.
