

Summary: The Department is proposing Solid Waste Rule (SWR) Chapter 18. The proposed Chapter 18 incorporates by reference the national regulations for the disposal of coal combustion residuals in landfills and surface impoundments. These requirements have been finalized under the solid waste provisions, Subtitle D, of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, specifically found in the Code of Federal Regulations, Title 40, Part 257, Subpart D. Incorporating these standards by reference ensures that the SWR Chapter 18 meets the federal minimum criteria. The proposed Chapter 18 was approved by the Water and Waste Advisory Board on December 21, 2021. Specific information on the proposed rule can be found in the Statement of Principal Reasons.
