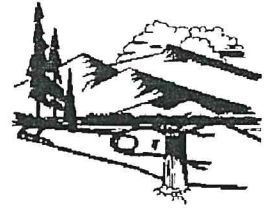

**SUMMARY:** The Department is proposing to adopt a new rule, Water Quality Rules 29, Geologic Sequestration Special Revenue Account Requirements. The proposed new rule identifies fee and timing requirements for Underground Injection Control Class VI well owners, operators, and permittees who are required to contribute to the Special Revenue Account created by Wyoming Statute § 35-11-318.
