Section 2

2(a)

Lorie Cahn, Water and Waste Advisory Board: Ms. Cahn recommended revising the definition of "carbon dioxide stream" by removing the comma after "carbon dioxide." The definition currently states, "carbon dioxide, plus associated substances derived from the source materials and any processing..."

<u>Department Response:</u> As discussed at the meeting, WDEQ/WQD is proposing to use the carbon dioxide stream definition already established in Water Quality Rules Chapter 24, which is the permitting chapter for facilities that will be subject to Chapter 29, once Chapter 29 is adopted and signed into effect.

2(b)

<u>Brian Deurloo, Water and Waste Advisory Board:</u> Mr. Deurloo recommended revising the definition of Class II wells by changing "water or fluids" to "material."

<u>Department Response:</u> As discussed at the meeting, WDEQ/WQD is proposing to use the Class II well definition that Wyoming Oil and Gas Conservation Commission uses in its regulations for Class II wells.

2(c)(i)

Lorie Cahn, Water and Waste Advisory Board: Ms. Cahn noted the comma between "sequestration" and "beneath" is unnecessary.

<u>Department Response:</u> As discussed at the meeting, WDEQ/WQD is proposing to use the Class VI well definition already established in Water Quality Rules Chapter 24, which is the permitting chapter for facilities that will be subject to Chapter 29, once Chapter 29 is adopted and signed into effect.
