ORDER

The Parties appeared for a pre-hearing conference in this matter on January 5, 2023 at 10:00 a.m. Present on behalf of the Petitioner were Dan Heilig and John Graham. Present of behalf of the Department was Nicole Budine.

Ms. Budine informed the hearing officer that the Department had revoked the permit being contested in this matter. The Petitioner agreed that the Department had taken steps to revoke the permit but was not prepared to agree to a dismissal of this matter due to several unanswered issues surrounding the revocation and the reclamation of the property.

The parties agreed that a continuance of this matter for a period of 60 days was appropriate and that they could come to an understanding of how best to proceed.

Therefore the following schedule is set.

- 1. The parties shall by 5:00 p.m. on February 24, 2023 file either a joint motion to dismiss, a contested motion to dismiss or such other motion as either party may deem appropriate under the circumstances as they exist on that date.
- 2. If any motion, other than a joint motion, is filed by either party than the responding party has 30 days from the date of filing of the motion to file a response. The moving party shall then have 15 days to file a reply to the response.
