Wyoming Environmental Quality Council Rulemaking Public Comment Period

The revisions include new requirements for public water supplies that propose well acidization, updates to water treatment technologies, the incorporation by reference of the Recommended Standards for Water Works, 2018 Edition, and minor corrections made since the chapter was noticed on August 31, 2022.
