## **ORDER DISMISSING ACTION FOLLOWING STIPULATION**

On August 29, 2024, the parties filed a Stipulation of Dismissal of Action. In the Stipulation, Jackson Hole Conservation Alliance and Teton Village Alliance (the Appellants) dismissed its action with prejudice under Wyo. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A)(ii). Appellants and the Department of Environmental Quality signed the Stipulation and agreed that each party shall bear their own costs and fees.

Although the Council has not adopted Wyo. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A)(ii) as part of its contested case rules, based upon the Stipulation, the Council dismisses the action with prejudice with each party to bear their own costs and fees.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that Appellants' action is hereby dismissed with prejudice with each party to bear their own costs and fees.
