JOINT STIPULATION DISMISSING APPEAL TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY COUNCIL

COME NOW Landrica Development Company ("Landrica") and the Department of Environmental Quality, Land Quality Division ("DEQ/LQD") by and through their respective undersigned counsel, and hereby stipulate as follows:

- 1. DEQ/LQD, based on information recently submitted by Landrica, has determined that there is evidence of a small extent of ground contamination with little chance of groundwater contamination, little or no contamination from the drill hole, and the penalty is reduced from \$25,000.00 to \$15,000.00 as provided by Paragraph 4, Decision of the "Director' Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Decision" In the Matter of a Notice of Violation Issued to Landrica Development Company, KFX Mine P.O. Box 1777, Gillette, WY 82717-1777 Permit No. 486-T5, Nov No. 100516, Docket No. 3928-06 (hereinafter "Director's Findings").
- 2. Pursuant to Paragraph 5 of the Director' Findings, the current review of the major revision to Landrica's permit shall continue and NOV No. 100516 will not be terminated until this Joint Stipulation
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revision package is approved by LQD.

THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, Landrica withdraws its appeal in the captioned matter.
