I received the enclosed Public Notice in the mail while I was temporarily absent from the State, and attempted to obtain more information about the application by sending the enclosed e-mail. I have not had the courtesy of a reply.

The Public Notice is deficient in describing or addressing any adverse affect of the proposed sand and gravel mining operation, including without limitation: noise and air pollution; public safety due to the heavy equipment and increased truck traffic; degradation of roadways, and quality of life issues.

As a recipient of the Public Notice and owning land near the proposed mining operation in Lincoln County, Wyoming, and for the reasons stated, objection is made to the application and it is requested that the Land Quality Division conduct such hearings as may be necessary to determine if the application should be denied or what conditions may be imposed on the operation to abate any adverse affect.

From the Public Notice it does not appear that the above Agency and Division within the agency has acted on behalf of the public interest in considering the approval of the application.
