Dear Mr. Sundin:


The above-mentioned notice has been received by the
City of Evanston and a request is hereby made for a hear-
ing before the Environmental Quality Council.

The City intends to present to the council evidence
at this time, of compliance to the conditions which have
already been met within constraints at the existing sew-
age treatment plant and proposals for improving the quali-
ty of operation during the limited remaining service peri-
od.

A new treatment facility will hopefully be in opera-
tion within the next two (2) years. The City wishes to
maximize the quality of effluent from the old plant. While
not investing large sums of money at the old location which
are going to be needed for the construction of the new fa-
cility.
