MOTION TO AMEND PETITION FOR REVIEW

Petitioners, Roger D. Pfeil and Linda Jo Pfeil, husband and wife, on behalf of themselves and their minor children ("Pfeils") and Joseph M. Gilsdorf ("Gilsdorf") and Karla J. Oksanen ("Oksanen"), by and through their undersigned attorneys, hereby move the Court for leave to submit an Amended Petition for Review in the above captioned matter. In support of this Motion, Petitioners assert the following:

1. The Petition for Review filed by the Petitioners on November 15, 1994, was proper in all respects except that it was 25 pages in length, rather than five (5) pages in length.

Respondents have objected to the length of the original
Petition as not conforming with the rules because it exceeds five
(5) pages in length.

3. Petitioners' time to appeal the original November 7, 1994 Order by the Environmental Quality Council, which serves as the basis of these proceedings, does not expire until December 7, 1994.

4. Petitioners will redraft and submit an amended Petition for Review that is no longer than five (5) pages in length, pursuant to the applicable rules on or before December 7, 1994.

5. No parties have been prejudiced by the filing of the original 25 page Petition for Review in a substantive way. The length of the Petition resulted from long and convoluted factual history of this matter and the numerous procedural, substantive and constitutional defects which will be issues in the appeal currently pending in this Court.

6. The mistake in submitting a Petition longer than five (5) pages was not intentional. If anything, responding parties have been given more information and record citation than they would normally get when such a Petition is filed. No one has been prejudiced by the longer Petition, except to the extent that it has required more time to read it. Petitioners apologize for any inconvenience this has caused.

7. Petitioners' counsel did not intentionally violate the rules and will gladly submit a short Petition so that the record is proper and contains a Petition for Review that does not exceed five (5) pages in length.

8. Since the time for appeal has not run, striking Petitioners' brief or rescheduling the proceedings that are currently before the Court would serve only to create more delay

and expense for all parties, and would not preclude the Petitioners from filing a shorter Petition for Review.

WHEREFORE, Petitioners, Roger D. Pfeil and Linda Jo Pfeil, husband and wife, on behalf of themselves and their minor children ("Pfeils") and Joseph M. Gilsdorf ("Gilsdorf") and Karla J. Oksanen ("Oksanen"), hereby request leave of Court to simply file an Amended Petition for Review in the above captioned matter on or before December 7, 1994.
