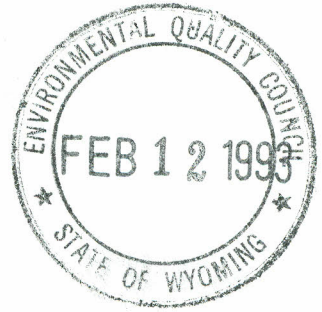

JOINT MOTION FOR STAY


The parties, by and through undersigned counsel, move the Council for an order staying any hearing in this matter, and as grounds for this motion offer the following:

1. On January 11, 1993, the Attorney General's Office sent a notice of bond forfeiture to Muller Construction, pursuant to this Council's approval, dated December 17, 1992.
2. On January 29, 1993, Muller Construction requested a hearing.
3. Pursuant to W.S. 35-11-421(c), the Council must hold a hearing within 30 days of the hearing request.
4. Muller Construction intends to reclaim the mine in question, and has submitted a reclamation plan to the Department of Environmental Quality, Land Quality Division.
5. The DEQ has received Muller Construction's reclamation plan and finds this plan acceptable. Based on this finding, the DEQ is willing to stay proceedings to allow Muller time to reclaim the mine.

THEREFORE, the parties request the Council stay any hearing of this matter until either party seeks further relief.
