ORDER FOR BOND FORFEITURE

This matter came before the Wyoming Environmental Quality Council pursuant to a request of the Department of Environmental Quality for approval to seek bond forfeiture against Muller Construction (Muller), which holds permit no. 786ET, and an objection to the bond forfeiture proceeding by Muller.

The parties have resolved this dispute and have entered into a Stipulation which sets forth facts, conclusions and terms of settlement. The parties ask that the Council enter an Order For Bond Forfeiture, based on the terms of the Stipulation.

The Council, having considered the parties' stipulation and having been otherwise fully informed,

ORDERS that the bond posted by Muller Construction for permit 786ET, certificate of deposit no. 2247 issued by the Sheridan National Bank totaling \$900.00, is hereby forfeited, pursuant to the terms of the parties' Stipulation, which is incorporated herein by this reference.
