STIPULATION

On June 11, 1982, the Air Quality Division, Department of Environmental Quality, issued a Notice of Violation and Order to Mobil, which was received on June 14, 1982. Mobil Coal Producing, Inc. filed a Petition For Hearing with the Environmental Quality Council on June 22, 1982.

Following the Petition For Hearing, informal conferences were held between personnel for the Air Quality Division and Mobil Coal Producing, Inc., on July 8, 1982, and July 30, 1982. Based on information and facts adduced at said conferences, it is stipulated and agreed as follows:

1. On or before 30 days following the final execution of this STIPULATION Mobil shall submit to the Air Quality Division for its approval supplemental information establishing the reallocation of emissions as provided by stipulation number 4 of its Air Quality Construction Permit No. CT-208.

2. As part of this submittal, it is Mobil's intent to hold the total allowable emissions for the Caballo Rojo facilities at the permitted level of 9.6 pounds per hour.

3. It is agreed that when Mobil submits the above-described information this matter shall be considered resolved to the mutual satisfaction of both parties. Accordingly, it is further agreed that the Notice of Violation should be vacated and any further proceedings before the Environmental Quality Council are unnecessary.
