ORDER

1. The Council by order of June 3, 1982, retained jurisdiction over this matter in order to determine what equitable conditions should be imposed upon Applicant's permit TFN 1 2/236.

2. The Council by order of June 3, 1982, instructed the Applicant and the Department of Environmental Quality, Land Quality Division, to work out an agreement to deal with those items identified in paragraphs 8, 9 and 10 of the Conclusions of Law set out in its Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law dated June 3, 1982.

3. The Applicant and the Department of Environmental Quality, Land Quality Division, submitted at the July 21, 1982, council meeting a document entitled, "Agreement Between Applicant and the Department of Environmental Quality, Land Quality Division".

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council having reviewed the aforementioned Agreement between the Applicant and the Department of Environmental Quality, Land Quality Division; being further satisfied that such Agreement is an equitable solution to those items identified in paragraphs 8, 9 and 10 of their Conclusions

of Law dated June 3, 1982; and being otherwise fully advised in the premises:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Agreement setting out certain conditions to be attached to Applicant's permit TFN 1 2/236, agreed to by the Applicant and the Department of Environmental Quality, Land Quality Division, and presented to the Council on July 21, 1982, is adopted and approved by the Council. That by such approval, the following conditions shall be attached to and become part of Applicant's permit TFN 1 2/236:

- a. Applicant shall water the haul road during its usage as may reasonably be required to control dust.
- b. Applicant shall regularly maintain cattle guards while using the haul road. After each season the Applicant uses the haul road, it will clean under the cattle guards and insure they are adequately connected to adjoining fences at both ends.
- c. Applicant shall blade down high spots as outlined in Exhibit "A" of the aforementioned Agreement so as to reduce snow accumulation on the haul roadway.
