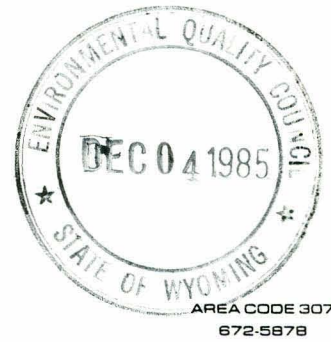

RE: Moorcroft Landfill No. 2

Dear Mr. Wood:

This office has been contacted by Marianne Moore, a landowner in Crook County, Wyoming, for the specific purpose of filing a formal protest to the design and construction of Moorcroft Landfill No. 2. We have been advised that the proposed landfill is to be located in the N $\frac{1}{2}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 1, T50N, R68W, Crook County, Wyoming. This proposed landfill is adjacent to property owned by Mr. and Mrs. Moore.

Mrs. Moore was initially informed by members of the Moorcroft Planning Commission that the landfill would be located in the southern extremity of the city's property. This would place the landfill a considerable distance from the Moore property and is not objectionable. However, recent information has indicated that the landfill is to now be constructed right next to the Moore property. The Moore's have operated a trailer court in Crook County for a number of years and may desire to expand the use of their land. A sanitary landfill in close proximity would significantly deteriorate the appeal of such a location. Furthermore, the Moore's are advised that there is a gas line in the area of the proposed landfill and have extreme concern about rupture and potential fire hazard.

Mrs. Moore has advised us that she would withdraw her protest if the Moorcroft Planning Commission would move the landfill to the southern extremity of their property. But, in its present proposed location, the Moore's do formally object and protest the development and use a a sanitary landfill immediately adjacent to their property.
