The APPLICANT: Woodrow and Christine Barstad
Property Owners, Bonded Operator, and Permit Holders of
DEQ Land Quality Permit (ET 1100) issued 11 February 1999 and Air Quality Permit (CT 1491) issued March 9,1999.

HEARING REQUEST: Woodrow and Christine Barstad come forth in objection to and request affirmative relief concerning relevant issues pertaining to DEQ Rules and Regulations.

- 1) DEQ Permit Application Documentation:
 - (i) compliance with the terms set forth and represented in the Official DEQ Permit
 Application documents. The original DEQ permits (ET 1100) "Authorization
 granted in this permit to produce sand and gravel from this pit shall remain valid for
 two (2) years from the issuance date of this permit" "the crushing activities will be
 limited to winter operations during the months of October through May".
 - see attache documents
- 2) Air Quality Permitting:
 - (i) Granting Operator status to Contractor without Land Owner/ Operator consent.

 Procedural requirement should apply to this process.
 - (ii) permitting the reissuing of a limited permit without land owner/operator consent.
 - (ii) the reissuing of a limited permit to a contractor with a standing Air Quality NOV. In addition this contractor and has also exceeded the 10 acre ET by 4.5 acres, without DEQ authority or permitting on said property.
 - (iii) the reissuing of a limited permit with additional expanded authority (processing additional material) that goes beyond the parameter of the original restricted Air Quality permit obtained by the land owner/operator and agreed upon by the contractor.
- 3) Disputes between Land Owner/ Operator and Contractor:
 - (i) in legal disputed issues between Land Owner/ Operator, and the contractor the DEQ

should adhere to all substantive commitments and descriptions set forth in the DEQ application. DEQ documentation should prevail and other documentation post presented to the DEQ should be directed to the appropriate legal process in the courts.

 - this letter was authored by Dave Nyenhuis. I brought the letters around to each neighbor for their signature.
