

MOTION TO DISMISS

On March 24, 1998, Caballo Rojo, Inc., ("Caballo Rojo") filed a petition for review, Docket No. 2925-98, appealing opacity monitoring conditions in its Section 30 operating permit, Permit No. 30-100. On August 6, 1998, Caballo Rojo filed a second petition for review, Docket No. 2962-98, appealing similar conditions in its Section 21 permit, Permit No. MD-318. On January 4, 1999, the Environmental Quality Council consolidated the two appeals under Docket No. 98-2601.

After filing its petitions for review, Caballo Rojo continued discussions with the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality. An agreement resolving the issues was reached fairly quickly. However, because it was necessary to amend Caballo Rojo's air quality permits, it took a significant amount of time to implement the parties' agreement.

The permits have now been amended, the settlement agreement has been implemented, and the issues raised in these appeals have been resolved. Caballo Rojo therefore moves the Environmental Quality Council to dismiss this matter.
